Fluence Wins Order for US Government

Fluence Corporation Limited (ASX: FLC; the "<u>Company</u>") is very pleased to announce that it has secured a US\$1.9M contract to supply four wastewater treatment plants to the US Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), part of the US Department of Homeland Security. The plants are expected to be delivered, with the corresponding revenue recognized, by the end of the 3rd quarter CY2022. The order was placed by SupplyCore Inc (SupplyCore), a major supply chain and technology integrator and small business Federal Defense contractor which has provided key support to the U.S. military and its allies since 1987. As a procurement representative in support of the US Federal Government, SupplyCore has been awarded a contract to procure up to US\$92M of water purification equipment over the next five years for the US Government¹.

The four plants are pre-engineered and use conventional treatment technology to meet the specific needs of the FEMA projects. Once installed, the plants will support hurricane relief efforts in Louisiana.

Commenting on this order, Tom Pokorsky, CEO and Managing Director, said: "We are very pleased to sign this contract with SupplyCore for FEMA. Given the increasingly tight US wastewater treatment standards and increasing water scarcity, we intend to offer our flagship products, MABR and Nirobox, in support of any potential future SupplyCore opportunities."
